Construction Notice

HIGHWAY 27 WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT, IN THE VILLAGE OF NOBLETON, TOWNSHIP OF KING, REGION OF YORK

Contract: 2016-T10

The Township of King works continuously to maintain the condition of our infrastructure and roads for motorists, cyclists and pedestrians. To improve the level of service to you, the Township of King has identified a need to replace an existing watermain on Highway 27, from Parkview Avenue to Wilsen Road. You are receiving this notice because the replacement will be in proximity to your residence or business.

The watermain replacement is scheduled to begin **June 22, 2016** or sooner and is expected to be completed on or before **September 15, 2016** weather permitting. To minimize disturbance to traffic flows, the work will be completed in eight (8) stages as shown on the back side of this notice – Figure 1. The contractor, Morretti Excavating Limited will be maintaining full time access to all residences and businesses on Hwy 27 within the work zone.

It is necessary for the contractor to decommission the existing watermain prior to any new installation, during which time your property will be connected to a temporary watermain by-pass system. You may notice a reduction of water pressure during this time period however this is the normal operation of a temporary by-pass system. You may also be contacted by the Contractor to briefly access your property in order to install the temporary water supply system. To facilitate the installation of the new watermain, the water supply to your residence or business will need to be temporarily shut off for short periods of time during construction. Be assured that you will receive advance notice from the Contractor prior to any water disruption to your water supply system.

Through traffic on Hwy 27 will be maintained during all stages of construction, however there will be lane reductions in place as required for the duration of the work. There will also be periods of time during which local road connections to Highway 27 will be closed adjacent to the work area. Additional notices will be distributed to property owners affected by these closures with specific dates of the closures as well as alternative traffic arrangements.

The Township will make every effort to minimize disruptions. We thank you for your patience and understanding.

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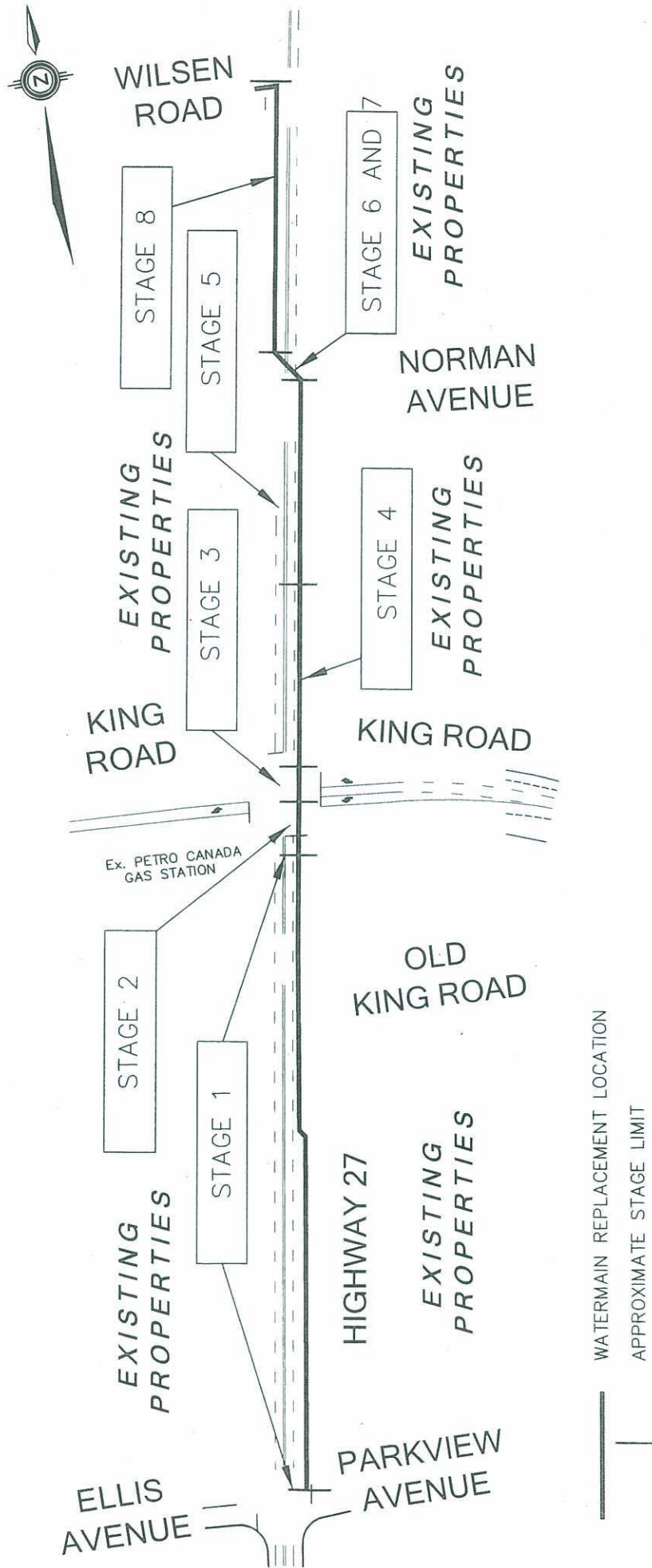
